

Subsidiarity you say



Challenge: Build the highest tower using just the materials shown

First steps → Choose a piece of equipment each and a group leader

Group 1 (Free for all)

Your leader likes to let others get involved.
No restrictions exist on who says or does what.



Group 2 (The Voice)

Your leader likes to take charge.
Other members are allowed to use one type of equipment but must only follow directions.
They cannot make any decisions.



Group 3 (Spotlight)

Your leader likes to do everything.
In fact, other members are only allowed to hold equipment and pass it on to be used. They are not allowed to make any decisions.



Questions for the debrief: How did your group go in the challenge? Did you feel like you were valued? Did you get to make decisions as you would have liked? What was your leader like? Did your group's decision making impact on your group's success? What can we learn about subsidiarity based on this challenge? How can we apply what we have learnt to real world situations we find ourselves in?
