<i>Composition: Focusing on the work of the composer in designing the song [60%]</i>		
Message	Is there a clear message? Is the message a voice for justice?	/10
Lyrics	How well crafted are the words to the song?	/10
Relevance	Does the message and theme fit in with 'A NEW WAY FORWARD' and CST?	/10
Structure	Does the structure of the song work (intro/verses/chorus/bridge/outro)?	/10
Melody	How effective is the main melody of the music? Is it memorable?	/10
Dynamics	Does the song use dynamics effectively (in terms of volume, pace, beat)?	/10
<i>Performance: Focusing on the presentation of the song and its effect on the audience [40%]</i>		
Instrumental use	What is the quality of the musicianship in terms of using vocals/instruments?	/10
Emotion	Can you feel the passion, authenticity and emotion in the performance?	/10
Impact	Does the song have a positive lasting impact on the listener? Is it memorable?	/10
Clarity / Quality	Can the words be easily understood? What is the quality of the recording like?	/10
