

THE STATISTICS GAME

Purpose: To uncover some facts about social injustice in the world.

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Print out a set of the Statistics Game Q&A.
2. Ask participants to form a circle and spread the Q&A sheets inside the circle.
3. Give the participants a maximum of 20 minutes to see if they can match the questions with answers.
4. Reveal the answers to the participants.
5. Finish with the final prayer reflection PowerPoint to pray for those living with the reality of these statistics. You might like to light a candle or create a sacred space for your prayer reflection.

ANSWERS TO THE STATISTICS GAME:

Q: There are 1.2 billion children in the world. How many on these children live in poverty?

A: 1 billion

Q: How many people lose their homes every year during a natural disaster?

A: 270

Q: How many women worldwide are victims of domestic violence?

A: 1 in 3

Q: What is the number of people who die every year due to a lack of clean water?

A: 1.6 million

Q: How many people live in the world without access to even a very basic toilet system?

A: 4 in 10

Q: How many people struggle every day live on less than \$2?

A: 2.7 Billion

Q: Poverty contributes to the existence of preventable diseases such as malaria, diarrhoea and pneumonia. How many children under five die from these diseases per year?

A: 11 million



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
