

## ***To follow up the CST videos***

***Using any of the seven videos online, here are some ideas to follow up.***

1. After viewing this video, locate in your Bible one Old Testament quote and one New Testament quote that link closely with the message of the story.
2. Locate online 'Evangelii Gaudium'

Go to paragraphs 186 – 192 and find a quote from Pope Francis that relates to this video. Create a bookmark with this quote written on it.
3. After viewing a video, think of a local example that could demonstrate a similar storyline or message.
4. Using the model of the CST card game, make a card based on the video scenario, using the sub-headings See, Judge and Act.
5. Create a short drama that uses See, Judge, Act incorporating one of the CST principles shown in the videos.
6. Create a freeze-frame that shows your understanding of one of the principles and share with the class. Can they guess which principle the group is demonstrating in their frozen shape?
7. Can you match the title of a song you know, to a CST principle, e.g. 'Lean on Me' for the principle of Solidarity.
